Aim & Objectives

The AdvisoryNetPEST project aims to **network and upgrade advisory services across the EU** to increase the **sharing of knowledge** and the **adoption of innovative solutions** to **reduce the use and risks of pesticides (RURP)** in all EU Member States, enabling the agricultural sector to achieve the targets proposed by the Farm to Fork Strategy.

Objectives

- **Develop an EU network of advisors** to reduce the use and risks of pesticides
- Identify, select, and shape novel approaches (NAs) to be adapted and replicated across the EU
- Exchange knowledge and train advisors to promote the adoption of the novel approaches by farmers
- Scaling up the NAs, fostering the adoption of innovative solutions by farmers






Results

AdvisoryNetPEST project will set a range of scaling activities to ensure a wide deployment of the Novel Approaches, in all EU countries:

- 36 cross visits
- 135 training, education and farm demonstration events
- 42 national AKIS technical workshops
- 42 brokerage events







Interaction with the AKIS

- AdvisoryNetPEST will support the integration of advisors in national and European AKIS networks, enhancing the exchange of knowledge on the Novel Approaches.
- AdvisoryNetPEST will embed the national networks of advisors within their local AKIS, increasing
 their technological competences on RURP through interaction with science and education
 institutions, and exploiting new solutions with an efficient use of policy measures.
- National AKIS face-to-face technical workshops will be organised (Years 2 to 4) and will provide a
 forum for advisors to present novel approaches, share their experiences, and discuss
 emerging issues with the AKIS actors.
 - A total of 42 workshops will be organised.
